FUNDING FOR THE PEOPLE

GROWS OPPORTUNITY FOR SMALL BUSINESSES

- Invests in programs to help small businesses and entrepreneurs access capital and contracting opportunities through \$1 billion for the Small Business Administration, including \$290 million for Entrepreneurial Development Programs
- Funds financial and technical assistance grants and the availability and affordability of small-dollar loans with \$295 million for Community Development Financial Institutions

PROTECTS CONSUMERS

• Supports working and middle-class families by increasing funding for consumer protection activities at the Consumer Product Safety Commission with \$139 million; antitrust, privacy, and cybersecurity work at the Federal Trade Commission with \$376.5 million; and financial protection activities at the Securities and Exchange Commission with \$2 billion

PROTECTS OUR DEMOCRACY

- Protects our democracy with funding to ensure the integrity of our elections, including \$75 million for Election Security Grants to help States secure election systems and improve election administration
- Provides \$20 million for Election Assistance Commission operating expenses to ensure the continued security and accessibility of Federal elections
- Strengthens our Judicial system with \$8 billion for the Third Branch to support court operations and programs, the timely processing of Federal cases, and increased security and protective services in courthouses
- Promotes the right to counsel with \$1.3 billion for the Defenders Services Program

REBUILDS THE IRS

- Rebuilds the Internal Revenue Service with \$12.6 billion, an increase of \$675 million, to provide better customer service to working families navigating the tax system
- Cracks down on big corporations and the wealthy who aren't paying their fair share with \$5.4 billion for IRS enforcement

COMBATS CRIME AND CORRUPTION AND PROTECTS VICTIMS

- Protects our communities from drug trafficking and its consequences with \$297 for the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas Program and \$106 million for the Drug-Free Communities Program
- Fights crime and corruption with \$161 million to combat money laundering through the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network and combats terrorist financing and enhances the enforcement of economic sanctions for human rights, corruption, and other sanctions programs with more than \$195 million for Terrorism and Financial Intelligence
- Promotes justice for the victims of civil rights cold cases with \$2 million for the implementation of the Civil Rights Cold Case Record Collections Act of 2018
