# **HOMELAND SECURITY**

**Chairwoman Lucille Roybal-Allard**Fiscal Year 2023 Appropriations Bill At-A-Glance



Provides **\$86.48 billion** to secure critical infrastructure and borders, bolster maritime security, respect the dignity of immigrants, and support disaster relief.

#### **Secures our Critical Infrastructure and Communities**

- Prevents cyber-attacks, roots out cyber intrusions, and protects critical infrastructure with \$2.91 billion for the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency
- Protects organizations at-risk of attack with \$615 million for the Urban Areas Security Initiative,
  \$520 million for the State Homeland Security Grant Program, and \$305 million for the Nonprofit
  Security Grant Program

## **Respects the Dignity of Immigrants**

- Respects the dignity of migrants with \$1.9 billion in new funding to improve processing, sheltering, and medical care at CBP and ICE
- Invests in Alternatives to Detention for migrants with \$442.7 million
- Provides \$268 million for U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, including \$109.6 million for the E-Verify program, \$133.4 million for refugee processing and \$25 million for the Citizenship and Integration Grant Program
- Includes \$800 million for the Shelter and Services Program for migrants, formerly known as the Emergency Food and Shelter Program- Humanitarian

### **Protects Border Security**

 Makes responsible investments in border security, including for border technology, to improve inspections at ports of entry, to hire more staff, and to strengthen body-worn camera programs at CBP and ICE

### **Promotes Maritime Security**

- Invests strongly in maritime security with \$11.63 billion for the Coast Guard, including for operational readiness, for infrastructure, and in Coast Guard personnel and families
- Allocates \$1.67 billion for significant investments in the Coast Guard's air and marine fleet and facilities to protect our maritime security interests, including for the Offshore Patrol Cutter program, Fast Response Cutters, MH-60 helicopters, and Polar Security Cutter.

### **Supports Disaster Response and First Responders**

- Prepares for major disaster response and recovery with \$25.67 billion for FEMA to carry out these efforts
- Includes \$720 million for firefighter grant programs
- Provides \$56 million for the Next Generation Warning System to improve the capabilities of public broadcasters to send critical emergency and civil defense warnings
