THE 2021 TRUMP BUDGET HURTS COMMUNITIES OF COLOR

President Trump's fiscal year 2021 budget proposes massive cuts and outright eliminations of discretionary programs that work to reduce disparities and improve outcomes for communities of color.

Disenfranchises Minority-Owned Businesses

Cuts funding for the Minority Business Development Agency by \$31.7 million, or 75.5 percent, significantly reducing support for disadvantaged firms.

Threatens Equal Employment Under the Law

Slashes the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission by \$27 million, or 6.9 percent, undermining legal protections against workplace discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or disability.

Neglects African American History

Eliminates the Historic Preservation Fund's Civil Rights grants, undermining the historic preservation of the African American struggle to gain equal rights in the 20th century.

Weakens Education for Minority Students

Eliminates the NOAA Educational Partnership Program with Minority-Serving Institutions and the NASA Minority University Research and Education Project, stripping away STEM opportunities for underrepresented students.

Cripples Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs)

Reduces funding for the Historically Black College and University Capital Financing Program by \$6 million, or 13 percent, inhibiting HBCUs from expanding their educational mission.
