Programmatic and Language Requests

The requirements remain unchanged from prior years and are detailed in the Subcommittee guidance document.

Community Project Funding

The Subcommittee on Homeland Security will accept Community Project Funding requests for only the following Federal Emergency Management Agency, Federal Assistance accounts:

- Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grants
- Nonprofit Security Grants
- **Emergency Operations Center Grants**

The Subcommittee will not accept project requests for any other account.

After reviewing the guidance document, please contact the Subcommittee staff with any questions about submitting member requests. For technical questions related to the request database, contact the Committee IT shop.

The deadline for submitting program, language, and Community Project Funding requests to the Subcommittee will be at 6:00 p.m. on April 16, 2021. There will be an opportunity to enter additional details related to program and language requests after the full fiscal year 2022 budget is submitted by the President.
