THE 2021 TRUMP BUDGET HURTS WOMEN AND GIRLS

President Trump's fiscal year 2021 budget proposes massive cuts to and outright eliminations of discretionary programs that work to advance equality, expand opportunities, and improve the financial and physical security of women and girls.

Attacks Women in the Workforce

Cuts funding for the Department of Labor's Women's Bureau by 75%, undermining efforts to achieve equality and economic security for working women.

Limits Teen Pregnancy Prevention

Zeroes out the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program, jeopardizing efforts proven to reduce teenage pregnancy rates.

Cuts Support for Working Mothers and Families

Zeroes out funding for afterschool programs, making it harder to keep children safe and provide support for working mothers and families during non-school hours.

Hurts Women Business Owners and Entrepreneurs

Cuts funding for Women's Business Centers by \$5.1 million, making it harder for women to access resources to start and grow businesses.

Harms Girls' Food Security and Education

Eliminates the Department of Agriculture's McGovern-Dole Food for Education Program, greatly reducing support for improved nutrition and literacy for vulnerable children around the world, particularly girls.
