Investing in Infrastructure



• TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

- \$61 billion for transportation infrastructure development from dedicated trust funds
- Federal Aviation Administration — \$17.7 billion
- Federal Railroad Administration — \$3 billion



• HOUSING INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS

- Community Development Block Grants — \$3.6 billion[†]
- Public Housing Capital Fund — \$2.9 billion[†]
- Home Investment Partnerships Program — \$1.75 billion[†]

Protecting the Vulnerable



- OFFICE OF PUBLIC & INDIAN HOUSING — \$32.7 billion, \$6.9 billion above the President's budget request
 - Public Housing Operating Fund — \$4.8 billion
 - Native American Programs — \$855 million

- OFFICE OF COMMUNITY PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT — \$8.6 billion, \$5.7 billion above the President's budget
 - Homeless Assistance Grants — \$2.8 billion
 - Housing Opportunities for People with AIDs — \$410 million

• RENTAL ASSISTANCE

- Tenant-Based Rental Assistance — \$23.8 billion
 - HUD/VA Supportive Housing for Homeless Veterans — \$40 million[†]
 - HUD/VA Supportive Housing for Homeless Native American Veterans — \$5 million[†]
- Project-Based Rental Assistance — \$12.6 billion



- OFFICE OF HOUSING — \$13.7 billion, \$1.1 billion above the 2019 enacted level, \$846 million above the President's budget
 - Housing for the Elderly — \$803 million
 - Housing for Persons with Disabilities — \$259 million



- OFFICE OF LEAD HAZARD CONTROL AND HEALTHY HOMES — \$290 million
- FAIR HOUSING AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY — \$75.3 million

Blocks the administration's public housing rule change on undocumented immigrants in affordable housing, threatening the housing of 55,000 children who are citizens or legal residents
