



CREATES AMERICAN JOBS

- Invests in renewable energy development, including offshore wind, with \$37 million for the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management’s Renewable Energy Program
- Cleans up pollution while rebuilding our nation’s crumbling infrastructure with \$3 billion for drinking water and wastewater infrastructure through the Environmental Protection Agency grants programs
Funds a \$250 million effort to reduce air pollution, remediate brownfields sites, build recycling infrastructure, and address wildfire smoke preparedness

CONFRONTS THE CLIMATE CRISIS

- Follows the science and develops common-sense standards to curb pollution with \$9.56 billion for the Environmental Protection Agency.
- Launches a renewed focus on land and water conservation with \$587 million to improve the health and resiliency of our nation’s most significant bodies of water through EPA’s Geographic and National Estuary programs

ADVANCES ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE

- Funds \$100 million for environmental justice activities to make significant progress on President Biden’s “EJ 2020 Action Agenda” by addressing unacceptable pollution in communities of color and underrepresented populations.

SUPPORTS NATIVE AMERICANS

- Supports Indian Country health care programs, providing \$6.6 billion for the Indian Health Service, which includes \$4.7 billion for health services and \$940 million for health facilities
- Honors the federal government’s responsibilities to Native Americans with \$3.6 billion for Bureau of Indian Affairs, Bureau of Indian Education, and Office of the Special Trustee, including \$7 million for a new Indian Land Consolidation account to acquire fractionated interests in trust land
