THE 2020 TRUMP BUDGET HURTS WOMEN & GIRLS

President Trump's fiscal year 2020 budget proposes massive cuts to and outright eliminations of discretionary programs that work to advance equality, expand opportunities, and improve the financial and physical security of women and girls.

- Attacks women in the workforce
 - Cuts funding for the Department of Labor's Women's Bureau by 74%, undermining efforts to achieve equality and economic security for working women.
- Hurts maternal and child health

Slashes the Department of Health and Human Services' Maternal and Child Health program by 15.5%, including the complete elimination of funding for maternal depression screening and treatment and for newborn hearing screening.

Hurts women business owners and entrepreneurs

Cuts funding for Women's Business Centers by \$1.1 million, making it harder for women to access resources to start and grow businesses.

Limits teen pregnancy prevention

Zeroes out the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program, jeopardizing efforts proven to reduce teenage pregnancy rates.

Cuts support for working mothers and families

Zeroes out the 21st Century Community Learning Centers program, making it harder to keep children safe and provide support for working mothers and families during non-school hours.

6 Cuts family planning

Imposes a massive 59% cut to bilateral family planning programs, which help women overseas access needed health services.

Harms girls' food security and education

Eliminates the Department of Agriculture's McGovern-Dole Food for Education Program, greatly reducing support for improved nutrition and literacy for vulnerable children around the world, particularly girls.
