Elon Musk and President Trump Politicize Disaster Relief, \$10 Billion Remains Frozen

The Trump Administration's politicization of natural disaster recovery hurts the entire country. With \$10 billion in Disaster Relief Funds frozen, Homeland Security Secretary Noem telling President Trump she wants to eliminate the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and the recent announcement that the Trump administration is ending FEMA's lifesaving Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities grant program, all signs point to Elon Musk and President Trump's next goal: destroy FEMA and leave States and territories on their own for the next disaster.

FEMA provides critical assistance to help families, businesses, and communities protect themselves against flooding, tornadoes, wildfires, hurricanes, and other major disasters. When natural disasters are becoming more frequent and severe, communities from California to Florida depend on FEMA to help them recover and rebuild. <u>Reducing the scope or eliminating FEMA</u> would have life-threatening consequences.
