



HOUSE REPUBLICANS' NEXT GOAL: **FIRE 72,000 TEACHERS**

NUMBER OF TEACHERS ELIMINATED IN HOUSE REPUBLICANS' 2026 EDUCATION FUNDING BILL

House Republicans' Fiscal Year 2026 [Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education bill](#), and its 11 percent cut of \$23.9 billion, furthers Republicans' goal of ending public education in America by kicking 72,000 teachers out of classrooms across the country.

Under this bill, Title I Grants to Local Educational Agencies are cut \$4.7 billion below the 2025 level—72,000 teachers could be removed from classrooms serving low-income students.

Below you will find state-by-state estimates of the number of teachers who could be fired if Republicans have their way.
