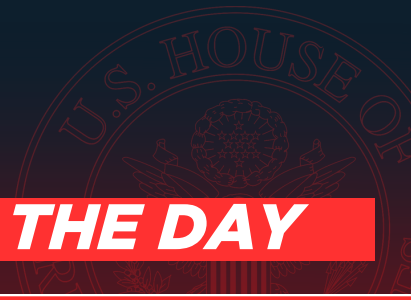

### They Finally Released the Files

House Republicans' "interim" suballocations hid the most devastating cuts from the Committee for more than a month. Now that they have released 10 of 12 bills it is easy to see that some of the most critical agencies that Americans depend on will suffer the brunt of the cuts with the deepest ones, targeting kids, classrooms, teachers, and the health and well-being of Americans for last.
