H.R. 2157 Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2019



The bill provides \$17.2 billion

in relief & recovery assistance for Americans affected by recent natural disasters through funding for:



Infrastructure, economic & community development



Assistance to farmers & rural communities



Nutrition & Medicaid assistance



Resiliency funding to mitigate damage from future disasters

The bill includes an additional \$3 billion to address urgent needs following flooding in the Midwest & tornadoes in the South:

- \$1.5 billion for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for repairs to Corps projects damaged by flooding and natural disasters
- \$1 billion for Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery to help communities rebuild housing, businesses, & public infrastructure
- \$500 million for the Department of Agriculture's Emergency Conservation Program for emergency funding & technical assistance to farmers & ranchers to rehabilitate farmland
